The Maritime Institute of Technology and Graduate Studies (MITAGS) offers one of the most versatile and cost-effective routes to your STCW - 95 Chief Mate/Master (CMM) certificates.

Comprehensive

In addition to the required training, MITAGS also offers most of the fifty-three (53) required assessments within the various courses to help minimize the inconvenience of trying to obtain these assessments at sea.



Cost Effective

The MITAGS Program can be completed in sixty (60) days for the current price of \$17,235.

If you take all of your CMM courses at MITAGS or PMI, you will receive a 10% discount (\$1,723) on the tuition. Additionally, we will provide a Radar Renewal and Flashing light exams at no additional charge (a \$450 savings). Note: The tuition rebate will be issued upon successful completion of all 12 weeks of training.

Hotel Accommodations

MITAGS offers affordable overnight lodging in our spacious 232-room hotel complex. The all inclusive overnight accommodations rate includes breakfast, lunch, dinner, break service, night lunch, free use of the recreational facilities, high-speed Internet access, and self-service laundry facilities. The commercial price is \$161 per night however if all Nine (9) CMM Courses are taken at MITAGS/PMI the price will be reduced to \$120 per night. This would be savings of \$2,460 over the 12 weeks.

A free, 24- hour shuttle service is also available to/from the Baltimore-Washington International (BWI) Thurgood Marshall Airport and the BWI Amtrak Train Station.

Course Duration and Pricing

Our full CMM Program, which covers all of the U.S. Coast Guard requirements, is only twelve (12) weeks in length. However, the course duration and cost can be reduced by up to two (2) weeks if the student has already completed MITAGS' Heavy Weather Avoidance (post 1998) and Electronic Chart Display and Information Systems (ECDIS) courses.

If all of the CMM courses are taken at MITAGS or PMI, the student will also receive a ten percent (10%) discount off of the cost of the License Advancement Program (LAP). Note: the current commercial list price for LAP is \$3,400.
